

## Survey Key

The survey begins with 5 statements in which the participants are asked to respond with a choice ranging from “Strongly Disagree” to “Strongly Agree.” These 5 questions were made up to model the cover story that the participants will be told. These statements do not make up a scale and the responses will not be analyzed.

1. I feel that taking notes by hand helps me remember more information.
2. I feel that when using my iPad in class, I am frequently distracted it.
3. I find that the iPad is a beneficial tool to my daily school life.
4. I feel that it is an inconvenience when a teacher does not allow me to use my iPad in class.
5. I feel that the school should continue to provide iPads to the students.

A 6-point Likert type scale was used for the Academic Stress Level, adapted from the Educational Stress Scale for Adolescents (ESSA), where the choices ranged from “Strongly Disagree” to “Strongly Agree.”

### **Academic Stress Levels Scale**

1. I feel a lot of pressure in my daily studying
2. I am very dissatisfied with my academic grades
3. There is too much competition among classmates which brings me a lot of academic pressure
4. I feel there is too much homework
5. I am extremely satisfied with my academic grades
6. My parents care about my academic grades too much which brings me a lot of pressure
7. I take classes that challenge me, but I am not overwhelmingly stressed

A 6-point Likert type scale was used for the Student Motivation Scale, adapted from The Motivated Strategies for Learning Questionnaire, where the choices ranged from “Strongly Disagree” to “Strongly Agree.”

### **Extrinsic Motivation Scale**

1. I like difficult schoolwork because I find it more interesting
2. I like school subjects where its pretty easy to just learn the answers
3. When I don't understand something right away I like to try to figure it out by myself
4. I work really hard because I enjoy learning new things
5. I like to ask the teacher how school assignments should be done
6. I do extra projects because they allow me to learn about things that interest me
7. If I get stuck on a problem I will keep trying to figure it out on my own
8. I like to stick to the assignments that are pretty easy to do
9. I do the schoolwork because the teacher tells me to
10. I work on my problems because I'm supposed to
